VIBO 2010 is the result of the combination of two different vineyards located in the Uco Valley's Altamira district, approximately 1150 m. (3,775 ft) a.s.l. The vineyards are planted on very well-drained sandy soils with a relatively low clay content. The vines average approximately 25–30 years in age. The vines are trained to a low vertical shoot position and cane pruned with a density of 4,500 plants per hectare.
