According to local archives, the Gonnet family has been settled in Bédarrides since 1600. The domain's holdings are made up of several vineyards, most of which are named after local landmarks, including Font de Michelle, La Crau, and La Pierre Plantée. Etienne Gonnet created Font de Michelle in 1950. Since 2006, Guillaume Gonnet has served as owner and winemaker of his family's Châteauneuf-du-Pape estate. In addition, he and his Australian wife Kelly have created this remarkable line of signature cuvées.

TASTING NOTE

Guillaume Gonnet's "Le Rêveur" is distinguished by its almost black color. The engaging bouquet evokes grilled meats, blackberry, and deep garrigue. In the mouth, the wine is explosive, peppery and juicy. Wet stones emerge with loads of garrigue on the finish.
