TASTING NOTE

Warmth, sharpness, and maturity are the dominant traits of this wine. Imprinted with mature fruits, its delicate and complex bouquet varies between an oaked aroma and red and black fruits. Notes of blackberry and blackcurrant blended with fine burnt overtones give the wine a soft and complex character. Its final silky taste makes it a pleasant and approachable wine.
