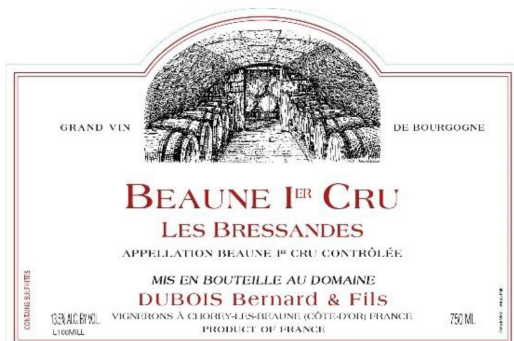


LES BRESSANDES

Burgundy Beaune 1er Cru



WINERY

Domaine Dubois Bernard is a tiny domaine of 7 hectares that is based in the village of Chorey-Les Beaune. The current owner and winemaker, Jacques Dubois, is the 5th generation of his family to make wine in this small village. Jacques continues his family's tradition of making terroir-pure wines from their small parcels around Chorey and Savigny. The domaine farms their high altitude parcels with extreme care, focusing on small yields and sustainable practices. Once in the cellar, extraction is kept to an absolute minimum, only indigenous yeasts are used, and the wines are aged and fermented in barrel.

TASTING NOTE

Fleshy and generous "the Bressandes" reveals great aromatic power and solid texture. This wine has a striking and vivid color - a luminous scarlet, introducing aromas of black fruits (blackcurrant, blackberry) and red (cherry, gooseberry) as well as humus and underbrush.

Vinification: Ages for 15 months in 25% new and 75% of second and third passage barrels from the Vosges and the Allier forests. These create a balance between fruit and oak roundness. Soil: the limestone disappears into the depths to be replaced by the overlying Rauracian. The slopes are quite steep and the soil (scree-derived black rendzinas) thinnish.
