### WINERY

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Ricardo Dumas from Bodegas Virgen de la Asunción established in 1957 is located in La Horra, Burgos in a small area known as “Triangulo de Oro” or “Gold Triangle” the name is given by the reputation of the outstanding quality of vines that grows there at 800 meters above sea level. The soil is rocky with clay. These components allow a well balance natural ecosystem for the plants. The vines have an average of 50 years and are hand harvested. Fermentation is done in stainless steel temperature control vessels that preserve the freshness and fruit aromas. Twenty days maceration process. Aging for 12 months on 60% American Oak and 40% French Oak.
