WINERY

This winery is a new project for Rafael de Haan in Vino de la Tierra de Castilla. This regional wine designation encompasses the southern third of Spain, roughly south of a line running through Madrid from east to west. The regional designation encompasses vineyards that lie outside of D.O.s and offer more winemaking freedom in terms of allowed varieties and methods. The climate is continental with very cold winters and hot, arid summers. Rainfall is low and controlled irrigation is necessary to keep the vines alive.

TASTING NOTE

Dark ruby. Aromas of fresh red and dark berries are complemented by suggestions of mocha and woodsmoke. Supple and broad on entry and then tighter in the middle, offering energetic black raspberry and mulberry flavors and a touch of peppery spices. Finishes gently tannic and smoky, with good persistence and a lingering blue fruit quality. This wine was aged for a brief two months in used French oak barrels.
