Garmon is a breeding obtained from three plots of Tempranillo Ribera del Duero near the town of Olivares de Duero, which ferments and rears the over 9 months on its lees in barrels of 500 liters.

La Bodega Garmón Continental is the smallest family winery with a production of 60,000 bottles. Bodegas Garmón is located in Valladolid, in the town of Olivares de Duero, about 20 kilometers from the famous Bodega Mauro, which produces wines from vineyards in organic certification.

TASTING NOTE

Inky ruby. Vibrant, assertively perfumed aromas of blackberry, cherry liqueur, cola and incense, plus a smoky nuance and a suggestion of vanilla. Sappy, seamless and penetrating on the palate, offering bitter cherry, dark berry liqueur and spicecake flavors complemented by licorice pastille and mocha flourishes. Turns sweeter and livelier with air and finishes floral and extremely long; silky smooth tannins frame the intense fruit.
