WINERY

PRADOREY sits on a privileged historical location founded back in 1503 by the Queen Isabel that belonged to the Royal family in the 15th and 16th centuries. The property hosts eight vineyards split into 144 micro terroirs and it is the largest private vineyard in Ribera del Duero and the biggest private estate in northern Spain.

Our winemaking philosophy is based on highlighting the tipicity of the terroir while respecting the characteristics of the grape and maintaining the freshness of the fruit.

Lia is another of Pradorey's innovative wines. It was the first Blush Rosé made in Ribera del Duero. With a pink blush, it is summery and aromatic. It maintains the structure and balance so typical of the Tempranillo grape.
