WINERY

In 1978 Bodegas Mauro was established by Mariano Garcia. The winery has been characterized for elaborating red wines with aging vocation and limited production. Balanced, opulent and sensual wines, claiming the identity of the terroir, the varietal characteristics and personality of the winemaker. Within the panorama of Spanish wines, Mauro produces wines modern style but with roots, attached to tradition and signs of identity that make them recognizable.

Mariano Garcia has been a legend in the world of wine since his teens. Son of a vineyard worker, he was put to work in the winery and trained at the School of Winemaking and Viticulture in Madrid. At the age of 24 he was made winemaker at the estate, which was Bodegas Vega Sicilia, the most prestigious winery in Spain. Mariano Garcia has always pushed boundaries to produce unique and expressive wines with great finesse. He revolutionized the industry in the 1980's and recognized the potential of Ribera del Duero, Castilla y Leon and Toro wines as top producers wine regions in the world.

TASTING NOTE

The opulent and generous 2015 VS is the reserva style bottling from Mauro and is sourced from two Tinto Fino vineyards, one in Traspinedo planted 70 years ago and a younger one (15 years old) in Tudela de Duero. The grapes from two vineyards are fermented separately in stainless steel with indigenous yeasts, and the wines matured in French and American barriques for some 26 months. It's powerful, concentrated, round and long within the more elegant style of this wine in the Mauro portfolio.
