The winery is found in the centre of the vineyard, in similar fashion to a château, in the Ebro valley, an area commonly known as Los Tres Marqueses because the vineyards of three important Riojan wineries founded by their respective marquises meet here. It is a wonderful location for growing grapes thanks to its continental climate enhanced by Atlantic influences. Its gentle topography has a high clay and limestone content that helps to produce balanced, full-bodied wines with high levels of total acidity that are particularly suited to ageing in barrels.

TASTING NOTE

Deep black cherry colour with violet rims and dark-chocolaty undertones. Fragrance of dark fruit as blackberries and mulberries enriched with aromas of violets. Extraordinarily complex and refined nose with developing hints of menthol and balsamic notes. On the palate, well combined tannins from oak and fruit add structure, notes of a wide spectrum of fruit flavours. Concentrated, sophisticated, elegant and great for extended cellaring.
