

TASTING NOTE

Deep red-violet colour. Rich, concentrated scents of plums and cherries with notes of vanilla and chocolate. In the mouth it is juicy, with layers of ripe red fruit, coffee and toasted flavours. Tannins are velvety and sweet, ending with a long fruity aftertaste.
