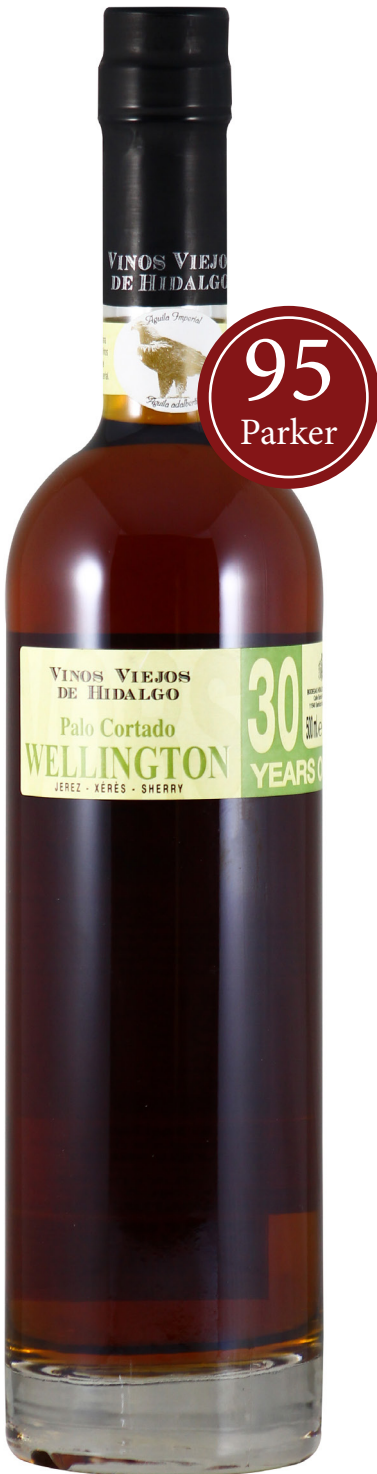


PALO CORTADO WELLINGTON VORS

TASTING NOTE

Aged for over 30 years, this is a highly select sherry matured slowly through a solera system aging. All the best characteristics of an Amontillado (complex and full nutty aroma) and all the best of an Oloroso (rich full smooth flavor). Extremely scarce and one of Hidalgo's "jewels".

Color: Dark, Mahogany.

Aroma: Complex fragrant with intense nuttiness.

Flavor: Dry, complex, very intense full array of flavors indicative of is great age. Very long on the palate.

Serving suggestions: Best served in a wine glass. Alone or with aperitif such as cheeses, nuts and pates. A perfect dry after dinner drink.
