WINERY

Monte Olmi is the name of this vineyard, located at Pedemonte di Valpolicella in the heart of Valpolicella Classica. The vineyard has a south-western exposure and is 2.5 hectares in size. It is laid out on terraces in order to ensure efficient draining in case of abundant rainfall. At the same time, the depth and the clay structure of the terrain serve to retain water during dry period.

TASTING NOTE

The 2009 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Riserva Capitel Monte Olmi is a wine of massive proportions and aspirations. This vintage marks the first time that this single-vineyard Amarone Classico is a Riserva. Capitel Monte Olmi sees a meticulous blend of up to eight indigenous grapes, all aged 48 months in barrel. It would be hard to exaggerate just how big this wine is. It shows its muscle in terms of chewy sweetness as well as the tightness of tannins that you normally do not encounter in Amarone. In fact, the wine is so big, it requires at least five more years of bottle aging to reach better integration.
