WINERY

The high altitude vineyards to the south and east of Calatayud (3,000 feet above sea level) largely consist of slate and quartzite over sandstone from the tertiary period shaped by glacial activity. These soils, largely made up of stones and crumbled slate, are low in nutrients. The extreme mountain climate and poor soils produce tiny yields of high quality fruit from our 40 year old Garnacha vines and 30 year old Syrah vines. The wine is aged for 9 months in French oak.

Bright ruby color. Fragrant, focused aromas of ripe red berries, vanilla and allspice. Juicy and energetic in the mouth, offering fresh raspberry and rose pastille flavors that deepen and spread out on the back half. The spice and floral qualities drive a sweet, silky finish framed by gentle, harmonious tannins.
